The Club is the largest provider of out of school programs in Jasper and Newton counties, serving youth 6-18. ## STEM

With STEM, Clubs can provide members who might otherwise not have access to STEM experiences with simple, fun, hands-on activities. The goal is to promote interest in and awareness of science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM) and provide STEM-related learning opportunities for traditionally underserved groups, including girls and young people of color.
